Draygon has two main lines of business - wastewater evaporators and concrete refinishing equipment and services.

Draygon is interested in marketing its line of wastewater evaporators in the Philippines.

The Draygon evaporation units have been developed to minimize waste streams, unnecessary transportation of waste products, liability and health hazardous pollution.

Evaporation units provide companies with a "green" approach to disposing of a multitude of water based waste streams generated by a variety of facilities, including but not limited to: Metal Finishers & Platers, Printers, Marinas, Metal Fabricators, Parts Washers, Food Processors, Electronics Manufacturers, Electroplaters, and In Processors.

These evaporators are used to reduce a wide range of waste water streams to a small volume or dry slurry for economical disposal. Such reduction by the evaporation process avoids the costs and liabilities of disposing of large volumes of aqueous waste streams, or risk penalties for disposing of such streams in ways that are illegal or harmful to the environment. The use of Draygon wastewater evaporators can also help companies meet national and local EPA related regulations.

Draygon makes five basic models of wastewater evaporators:

1. 2 gallons/hour, electric powered
2. 5 or 7 gallons per hour, electric powered
3. 20 or 35 gallons per hour, natural gas or lpg powered
4. 70-120 gallons per hour, natural gas powered
5. 25 gallons per hour, fueled by waste oil

All of Draygon's evaporators have stainless steel evaporation chambers and are available in other materials such as titanium and non stick coatings. Most can also be equipped for automatic operation with PLC controllers.

Draygon is interested in finding Philippine companies interested in offering sales and service for these evaporators to Philippine customers. While prospective companies do not have to be in the environmental equipment business, they do need to be active in marketing to the types of companies most likely to be interested in this Draygon equipment for disposing of waste streams from operations such as printing (inks/dyes), vehicle washes, photo processing, metal fabrication, metal finishing/plating, floor scrubbing, marina bilge water clean up, ceramic coating, compressor condensate, degreasing operations, screw machine shops, truck/car washes, etc.
